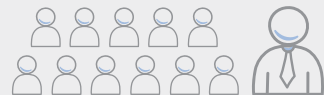

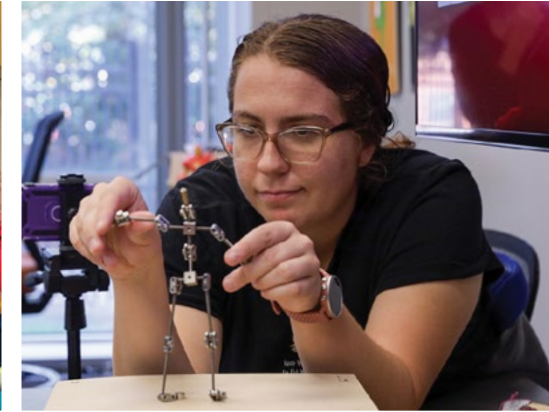

QUALIFICATIONS

Because the president must embody Bradley's mission of "empower[ing] students for immediate and sustained success in their personal and professional endeavors by combining professional preparation, liberal arts and sciences, and co-curricular experiences," candidates are expected to demonstrate evidence of a deep understanding and appreciation of the challenges and opportunities facing 21st century higher education. Candidates for the Bradley presidency would demonstrate the following attributes:

- Significant experience as a strategic leader of complex organizations
- A strong moral compass and the highest level of integrity
- Emotional intelligence, including humility, empathy, and authenticity
- Demonstrated success in managing the financial and business operations and budgeting as well as the ability to communicate financial information clearly to the Bradley community
- Recruit, select, and support exceptional talent and promote professional development throughout the university

Innovative and Creative Thinking

- Substantial knowledge of higher education admissions and retention issues
- A demonstrated appreciation of the importance of higher education
- A record of success and commitment to diversity, inclusion, and belonging
- Possess a strategic mindset to anticipate Bradley's future needs

Consultative Leadership Approach

- A transparent style of decision making that inspires trust
- Experience operating in a shared governance model of higher education
- Demonstrated success in setting priorities and leading organizations or teams to successful outcomes
- Listens and genuinely solicits the ideas and opinions of others, and is comfortable with the healthy exchange of opinions, to make well-informed decisions
