The 2017-2018 recruiting year was a strong year for Foster College of Business graduates, with a career outcomes rate exceeding both five- and ten-year average rates. Graduates reported accepting employment offers to work at a wide range of 139 different organizations. Ten undergraduate major tracks reached a career outcomes rate of 100%, including the double-digit graduating classes in the Accounting 3/2 track and Finance. 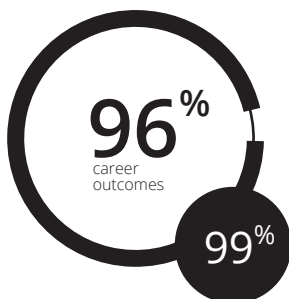

Baccalaureate graduates have a strong career outcomes rate of 96% (up from 93% 2016-17). Of the 17 majors within the college, 11 reported a 100% career outcomes rate. Many of the students remained in the state of Illinois where top employers include Northwestern Memorial Hospital; OSF Saint Francis Medical Center; Unity Point Health; Barnes-Jewish Hospital; Athletico; and Peoria Public School District 150. 15 students are employed outside the state with 2 outside the U.S. The majority of students who are continuing their education are pursuing healthcare careers such as physical therapy, physician's assistant, dietetic internships, exercise physiology, public health, medicine, and nursing. Top schools for graduate studies include Bradley University; John Hopkins University; St. Louis University; University of Illinois Urbana - Champaign; and University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics.

Data was gathered from 98% of the undergraduate class (197 graduates, 193 responded); 93% (179) are employed (equal to 2016-17). Engineering graduates are employed at 126 different organizations in 16 states. Of the employed respondents, 73% (131) are in Illinois. Organizations employing three (3) or more students include Blattner Energy, Inc.; Caterpillar Inc.; Christopher Glass & Aluminum; CNH Industrial; Deere & Company; EASI, LLC; EN Engineering, LLC; Graycor Inc.; Honda R&D Americas, Inc.; NTN Bearing Corporation; and Power Construction. Graduate School was the destination of choice for 4% (8) of the class -- up slightly from 3% in 2016-17.

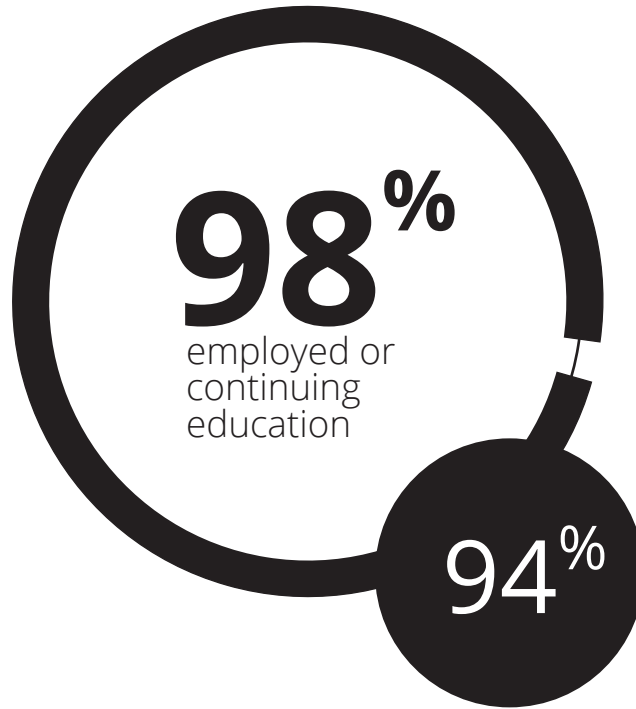
Of the 204 LAS graduates, 93% responded to the survey (down 2% from 2016-2017). Graduates continuing their education, 26% (down 3% from 2016-2017), will do so at 32 schools in 13 states, Puerto Rico, and Trinidad. Notable areas of study include Medical-related (12), Social Work (6), Law-related (4), Chemistry related (3), English (3), Psychology-related (2), Biological Sciences (2), and Library and Information Science (2). Sixty-six percent of graduates (66%, up 3% from 2016-2017) indicated they are employed. Many of the employed graduates plan to remain in Illinois, a rate of 68%; while 32% are headed to other locations including 13 states and 6 countries including Finland; China; Morocco; United Arab Emirates; Denmark; and the United Kingdom.

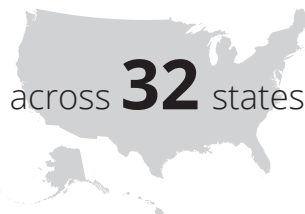

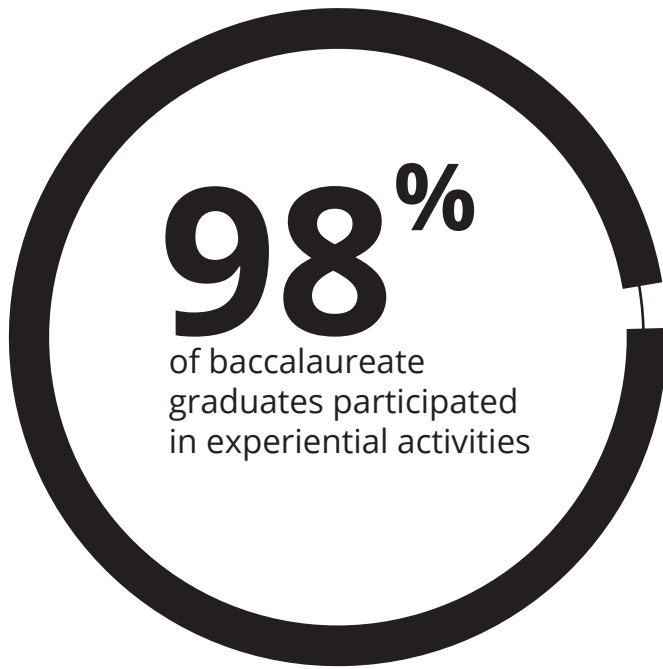

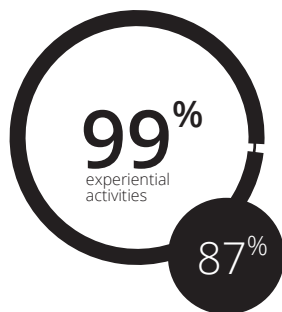

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Scope and Methodology

This report includes data about the August 2017, December 2017, and May 2018 Bradley University baccalaureate and graduate degree recipients. The study utilizes data from 96% of all baccalaureate degree recipients and 94% of all advanced degree recipients. Data was collected from students via graduation fair surveys, online surveys, telephone and email solicitations, alumni records, social media research, and input from faculty, staff, and employers. Data collection began in August 2017 and concluded in December 2018.

Career Outcomes and Knowledge Rate

The Bradley University career outcomes rate for the 2017-2018 baccalaureate graduating class is 93%. This is comparable to both our five (93%) and ten year (92%) and 1% higher than our 2016-2017 career outcomes rate of 92%. The career outcomes rate is calculated by dividing the number of students who are employed or continuing their education by the total number of students about whom we have information. We successfully contacted, surveyed, and/or researched 949 of our baccalaureate graduates which resulted in a 96% knowledge rate. The term “knowledge rate” defines the percentage of graduates for whom we have reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates’ post-graduation career activities. Our knowledge rate is considerably higher than the national recommended minimum knowledge rate of 65%.

Experiential Activities

The Bradley University experiential activities rate for the 2017-2018 baccalaureate graduating class is 98%. This was calculated by tracking students' participation in opportunities such as: internships, co-ops, practica, faculty-led research, capstone projects and study abroad. For experiential learning, internships play a significant part. Of the 992 graduates, 85% had a career-related experience, such as an internship or practicum. Baccalaureate graduates interned with 633 different employers in 24 states and 11 countries.

Employers

Baccalaureate degree graduates were employed with 534 different employers in 34 states and 12 countries. The diversity found within this group is a benefit for our students. Employers with a strong recruiting presence on campus include: Caterpillar Inc., COUNTRY Financial, Deere & Company, Enterprise Rent-A-Car Company, Fastenal, HNI | HON | Allsteel, Hy-Vee Inc., OSF HealthCare System, Produce Pro Software, RLI Corporation, State Farm Insurance, Target Corporation, Turner Construction, U.S. Marine Corps, and WCIC.

Smith Career Center

95% of baccalaureate graduates used the services of the Smith Career Center while attending Bradley University. In 2017-2018 we provided 61 workshops for ALL students and 74 presentations to classes or groups. Career Advisors met one-on-one with 2,221 students (unique) for a total of 4,441 appointments. The Smith Career Center remained a top source of job leads for accepted positions when students utilized resources such as internships, job fairs, and Bradley netWORK.

Standards and Protocols

The terminology, standards, and protocols of the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) are utilized throughout this study. NACE is the preeminent national organization focused on the employment of the college educated. In addition to these standards, the data collection, analysis and reporting of the Smith Career Center First Destination Study was internally audited in 2016.

EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITIES HIGHLIGHTS OF BACCALAUREATE GRADUATES

The Springer Center for Internships administers Bradley's centralized Cooperative Education and Internship Program and tracks students' participation in experiential activities, such as internships, co-ops, practica, faculty-led research, capstone projects and study abroad. Highlights include:

- 98% (969) of all baccalaureate graduates participated in an experiential activity.
- 85% (843) of all baccalaureate graduates had a reported career-related work experience such as an internship or practicum.
- Baccalaureate graduates reported 1,172 internships in the Peoria area. This represents 63% of those internships reported to the Smith Career Center. The Peoria area is defined as all the cities in Marshall, Peoria, Stark, Tazewell, & Woodford Counties.
- Baccalaureate graduates reported 294 internships in Chicago and the surrounding suburbs. This represents 16% of those internships reported to the Smith Career Center. Chicago and the surrounding suburbs are defined as all the cities in Cook, DuPage, Lake IL, Lake IN, and Will Counties.
- Baccalaureate graduates conducted internships with 633 different employers.
- Baccalaureate graduates interned in 24 different states (see below).
- Baccalaureate graduates interned in 11 countries outside the U.S. (see below).
