



Information was obtained from 96% of the undergraduate class (169 graduates, 162 respondents), resulting in a 96% career outcome rate: 91% are employed, and 5% are pursuing graduate school. This 96% surpasses the five and ten-year averages of 94%. Engineering graduates continued to report salary data more consistently than the other colleges, 81%, up 4% from the previous year. Salaries met or exceeded the national averages reported by NACE. Graduates are working at 101 different organizations across 16 states. Notable employers include Caterpillar (24), Northrop Grumman (7), Milwaukee Tool (5), Komatsu America Corp. (4), and IMEG (3). Graduates continuing their education have enrolled at Bradley University (3) and one each at Purdue, Pennsylvania State University, Colorado, Illinois, and Michigan. Additionally, 97% of the graduating class actively engaged with the Smith Career Center through appointments, fairs, workshops, and employer-related information sessions. *Rick Smith, Ph.D., Career Advisor*

The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences produces the most graduates (288) among each baccalaureate class. More than half of the 2023-2024 graduates directly entered the workforce while the 72 graduates attending graduate school are the highest among Bradley's colleges. OSF and Caterpillar were the two most common employers for LAS graduates. Some other employers are Americorps, Deloitte, Glen Ellyn Park District, Epic Systems, the Illinois Legislature, Ferrara Candy, Thermo Fisher Scientific, and the Washington DC Metro Police. Some graduate school destinations include: Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Notre Dame, Penn, Purdue, Washington (St Louis), and Wisconsin. 


2023-2024 BACCALAUREATE GRADUATES EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITIES & REGISTERED INTERNSHIPS

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

New This Year

Bradley University recently reorganized graduate education, eliminating the Graduate School and aligning them with their respective colleges. In this report, we reorganized the reporting of graduate outcomes and salary information to reflect this.

Internships and Experiential Learning

The First Destination Study has traditionally reported on the internship and experiential learning history of each graduating class. Since the 2022 First Destination Study, the percentage of students completing a Registered Internship is reported along with the percentage of students completing an Experiential Learning activity. Registered internships are approved by representatives of each College and require students to enroll in a co-op/internship course, which integrates classroom theory with career-related work experience. New first year students admitted in fall 2020 had Experiential Learning included as a Core Practice of the Bradley University Core Curriculum. This graduating class of 2024 had a large number of these students.

Scope and Methodology

This report includes data about the August 2023, December 2023, and May 2024 Bradley University baccalaureate and graduate degree recipients. The study utilizes data from 86% of all baccalaureate degree recipients and 93% of all advanced degree recipients. Data were collected from students via graduation fair surveys, online surveys, telephone/email/text solicitations, alumni records, social media research, and input from faculty, staff, and employers. Data collection concluded December 31, 2024.

Career Outcomes and Knowledge Rate

The Bradley University career outcomes rate for the 2023-2024 baccalaureate graduating class is 93%, which is slightly above the five-year average (91%). The graduating class experienced the COVID-19 Pandemic, which continues to influence outcomes and averages.

The career outcomes rate is calculated by dividing the number of students who are employed or continuing their education by the total number of students about whom we have information. We successfully contacted, surveyed, and/or researched 964 of our baccalaureate graduates, which resulted in an 86% knowledge rate. The term "knowledge rate" defines the percentage of graduates for whom we have reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities. Our knowledge rate is considerably higher than the national recommended minimum knowledge rate of 65%.

Registered Internships

The Bradley University registered internship rate for the 2023-2024 baccalaureate graduating class is 40%. Of the 964 graduates, 40% (382) had a *registered* internship. Baccalaureate graduates conducted *registered* internships with 255 different employers. The rate of registered internships increased from 25% in 2021-2022 to 37% in 2022-2023 to 40% in 2023-2024. The earliest registered internship completed by a member of this class was in Spring 2020.

Employers

Baccalaureate degree graduates were employed with 414 different employers in 32 states and 5 countries. Graduate Degree Recipients were employed with 311 different employers in 39 states. The diversity of employers is a benefit for our graduates.

Smith Career Center

93% of baccalaureate graduates used the services of the Smith Career Center while attending Bradley University. There are multiple ways for students to engage with the Smith Career Center. 80% (775) of this graduating class engaged in individual meetings with SCC staff members (scheduled one-on-one appointments, walk-ins, phone meetings, and significant email engagements). 62% (594) of the class attended at least one career fair.

Standards and Protocols

The terminology, standards, and protocols of the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) are utilized throughout this study. NACE is the preeminent national organization focused on the employment of the college educated.

<u>The NACE First-Destination Survey Standards and Protocols</u> encourage continuous engagement with graduates so that *data collection is ongoing rather than episodic*, accept a variety of *legitimate sources of finding critical outcome information*, and support the collection of data that *are reliable and verifiable*. Some students in this class had indicated that they were seeking employment prior to their graduation. Multiple attempts were made to verify this information: by email, text, and phone call; through internet searches including social media searches; by examining activity evidence in Bradley netWORK; and by outreach to academic faculty and student services staff. If we had no other information collected at any time after their graduation, we were unable to verify the accuracy of their status so these students were classified as Not Reported.

Communication with NACE Research Staff advised excluding extreme salary outliers defined as values below minimum wage and above \$1,000,000. Minimum wage is defined as the Illinois minimum as of 2024.
